His latest treatment, Biostimulation, is a must for all breeds of party animal, as it vaporises dark circles before you can say hello to your hangover. There's also a bespoke wrinkle-smoothing service, mixing and matching fillers to specific needs. He is a genius at getting rid of smokers' lines around the mouth using tiny pinpricks of Restylane to elevate fine lines rather than fill them, thus avoiding trout pout.

She skilfully recontours faces – no weirdness, just a big dose of wonderful – and has a 3D approach that looks at the whole visage. Cheeks flatten as we age, so she aims to very softly bring volume up with minimum puff.
