

French flair

However, it is his amazing 10-minute facelift that has been making headlines as the perfect age-defying treatment. This hi-tech facelift works by increasing the skin's collagen fibres, which are essential for moisturising the skin, improving its elasticity and reducing wrinkles.

It involves injections of biphasic tricalcium phosphates (BTCPS), a new biodegradable agent composed of phosphate and calcium ions suspended in hyaluronic acid, to create a facelift effect. The ingredients hold up sagging skin while encouraging the body to produce natural 'face-lifting' collagen.

Unfortunately, it's not completely pain-free (as they say, 'no pain, no gain') but a strong numbing

cream applied before the treatment reduces the pain and some of the bruising afterwards – and it's all over in 10 minutes.

The result is a smooth, radiant complexion and a lift to the face that can be seen almost immediately. And within six weeks, the real effects appear – new tissue, an increase in collagen fibres and improvement in elasticity – which last for 15 months, with just three sessions. The effect is subtle and very natural, as you would expect from a man who works with chic Parisians, but according to Dr Dray, this treatment could hold back a surgical facelift for many years.
